Cemeteries' Records – Cemetery Factsheet



Totnes Cemetery



Totnes Cemetery was formed in 1856 in Plymouth Road, Follaton and in 1897, extended over 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres. It now consists of 11 acres of burial ground and still incorporates a chapel which is a listed building.

In 1897, Thomas Cockings was the Cemetery Keeper, and Nicholas Adams of 10 High Street, Totnes was the Clerk to the Totnes Municipal Borough, which was responsible for the cemetery's management. It is now managed by Totnes Town Council, which holds the burial registers.
